The California High-Speed Rail Authority's public Board Meeting will be held Wednesday, May 14, 2008, at the Anaheim City Hall Council Chambers, 200 S. Anaheim Boulevard, in Anaheim, CA. **Please note the meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:30 am.**

At this meeting, staff will present a briefing on the proposed Station Area Development Policies. The Financing team will provide an update on the Request of Expressions of Interest (RFEI) work. The Program Management team will present a briefing on the work to date of the Anaheim to Los Angeles corridor. The Communications Manager will present an overview of the new California High-Speed Rail Authority website. Additionally, the City of Anaheim will give an overview and update on the ARTIC Station and the transit oriented development proposed in the station area.

At the April 2, 2008 meeting staff presented potential "Station Area Development" policies as an informational item. The Financing team updated the board on the "Request for Expressions of Interest" and presented an overview of a proposed Economic Impact Study. Additionally, staff reported on pending legislation affecting the High-Speed Rail Authority and the proposed high-speed train system and the board adopted AB 3034.
