

The Economic Impact of California High-Speed Rail

From July 2006 through June 2016, the California High-Speed Rail Authority has invested over **\$2.3 billion** in planning and constructing the nation's first high-speed rail system.

has been paid to certified Small, Disadvantaged, and Disabled Veteran Business enterprises in California for their work on the high-speed rail program.



52%
