## PHOTO RELEASE: Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Gymnastics Beat in Fresno

**FRESNO, Calif.** – Today, local gymnastics company, Gymnastics Beat, held a ribbon-cutting ceremony at its new location in northwest Fresno. Impacted by the high-speed rail alignment, the company has moved to a new 18,000 square-foot building at 4589 W. Jacquelyn Avenue. The relocation allowed the gymnasium to expand 6,000 square-feet and now provides a modernized facility to accommodate future growth.



Thanks to the combined efforts of Gymnastics Beat, the California High-Speed Rail Authority, Fresno Economic Development Corporation and the City of Fresno, the local gymnasium was able to find a suitable location to continue its operations in Fresno. With an enrollment of more than 600 students, the relocation will allow the company to grow its existing student membership, offer additional classes and expand its operations in the region.

Operating since 2003, Gymnastics Beat offers classes for kids six years old and above. Students learn gymnastics skills, including tumbling, bars, rings, beam and vault.
