Road Closure on F Street in Fresno Alternative Routes Advised

FRESNO, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with the design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures in Fresno starting expected to start on Monday, March 30. Detours will be in effect during the closures and motorists may experience delays. Signage will be in place to redirect traffic. Pedestrian access will not be restricted.

The lane closure is in place as part of the final street paving of storm drainage construction activities. This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 29-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 17 in Madera County to East American Avenue in Fresno County.

CLOSURE: F Street, between Tulare Street and Kern Street

The road closure is estimated to begin on Monday, March 30 at 9:00 a.m.
F Street is expected to fully reopen on Monday, April 20.

DETOUR: Motorists are advised to use G Street and E Street as alternative routes.

This schedule is subject to change.

Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas. The Authority appreciates the patience and cooperation from visitors, residents and businesses during this work.
