Demolition and Road Closure Activities Starting April 13

FRESNO, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), announces demolition and road closure activities in Fresno and Kings Counties as part of work for Construction Package 1 with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP) and Construction Package 2-3 design-build contractor, Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV).

CONSTRUCTION PACKAGE 1: Demolition at 545 H Street (Dollar World) in Fresno expected to last for 3 weeks

- **Lane & Sidewalk Closure 1:** The eastbound lane and sidewalk on Ventura Street between G and H streets will be closed from approximately 7 a.m. on Wednesday, April 13, 2016 to Tuesday, April 26, 2016.
- **Lane & Sidewalk Closure 2:** The southbound shoulder and sidewalk on H Street between Ventura and Santa Clara streets will be closed from approximately Wednesday, April 13, 2016 to Tuesday, April 26, 2016.

CONSTRUCTION PACKAGE 2-3: Shoulder closures as part of utility work in Kings County

- **Closure 1:** Shoulder closures on 9th Ave., between Cairo and Corona Avenues in Laton are scheduled for Wednesday, April 13, 2016.
- **Closure 2:** Shoulder closures on Grangeville Road between 7 ½ Ave and 7th Ave in Hanford are scheduled for Wednesday, April 13, 2016.
- **Closure 3:** Shoulder closures on Nevada Avenue between State Route 43 and Guiberson Avenue in Hanford are scheduled for Friday, April 15, 2016.
- **Closure 4:** Shoulder closures on Jackson Avenue between State Route 43 and 7th Ave. in Hanford are scheduled for Friday, April 15, 2016.
- **Closure 5:** Shoulder closures on State Route 43 between Nevada and Lansing Avenues in Hanford are scheduled for Friday, April 15, 2016.

Detour: Motorists may experience momentary delays; pedestrian access will be restricted.
