



CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

LANE CLOSURE ON CONEJO AVENUE IN FRESNO COUNTY

Issued: June 15, 2018

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a lane closure on Conejo Avenue between Willow and Topeka avenues in Fresno County for irrigation line relocation work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 18 and continue for approximately two days.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.



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Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.

Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel.
