ROAD CLOSURE IN MADERA COUNTY ALTERNATE ROUTES ADVISED

ISSUED: NOVEMBER 1, 2016

FRESNO, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP), announces State Route 145 at the BNSF railroad crossing in Madera County will be closed for construction activities scheduled to begin the evening of Tuesday, November 1, 2016.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County to East American Avenue in Fresno County.



State Route 145 (SR 145) at the BNSF railroad crossing in Madera County will be closed as part of continued construction work at the Fresno River Viaduct project site.

The closure is scheduled to begin at 10:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 1 and continue through 5:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 2.

Traffic going northbound on SR 145 will be detoured east to Storey Road (Avenue 15 ½) , then north on Road 29 (Santa Fe Drive). Road 29 (Santa Fe Drive) will connect to the SR 145.



Traffic going southbound on SR 145 will be detoured to Road 29 (Santa Fe Drive), then west on Storey Road (Avenue 15 ½). Storey Road (Avenue 15 ½) will connect to the SR 145.

Drivers may experience delays; signage will be in place to redirect traffic. Pedestrian access will also be restricted.

Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas.
