SHOULDER CLOSURES ON ROUTE 152 PACHECO PASS HIGHWAY

ISSUED: MAY 31, 2017

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with geotechnical consultant, Kleinfelder Inc., announces shoulder closures on Route 152 Pacheco Pass Highway in Santa Clara County for field work associated with geotechnical explorations within the Silicon Valley to Central Valley line that started on Monday, May 22, 2017.

This work is being done to understand geologic and hydrogeologic conditions near and around locations in close proximity to proposed alignment alternatives under consideration. This work supports future engineering, environmental and procurements. Kleinfelder Inc. will be performing rock coring activities using a mud-rotary rig.

A final alignment alternative through this area has not yet been selected, and will be done so through a public environmental review process.
