




Downtown Fresno Station

- **Alignment 1**
 - Elevated station east of UPRR right-of-way
 - Consistent with Fresno's economic development and redevelopment objectives
 - Requires relocation or integration of historic SP Station
 - Platform between Tulare and Merced Sts (centered on Mariposa)
- **Fresno West** and **Fresno Cross**
 - Elevated station west of UPRR right-of-way
 - Pedestrian access over UPRR tracks required to/from
 - Platform between Tulare and Merced Sts (centered on Mariposa) downtown










HST Guideway Cross-Section at Fresno Station

Design Option 6B

- **Adjacent to west side of Union Pacific Railroad and Railyard right of way and east side of SR 99**
 - **Requires realignment of SR 99 to the west between Ashlan Avenue and Clinton Avenue to accommodate 50' HST right of way and future Caltrans improvements on SR 99.**
 - **On elevated structure, at-grade option between Herndon Avenue and Shaw Avenue**







Design Option 8

- **Same as Design Option 6B except between Shaw Avenue and McKinley Avenue, where it is located to the west of SR 99**
 - **Minimize impacts to SR 99**
 - **Entirely elevated between San Joaquin River and McKinley Avenue**
 - **A lower-profile elevated structure option feasible between Shaw Avenue and the future planned extension of Veterans Blvd**






Alignment Alternatives North of Clinton Avenue

Common Features of Alignments North of Clinton Avenue


- **Elevated structure between Ashlan Avenue and Clinton Avenue (approximately 60 feet high)**
- **Elevated bridge over San Joaquin River**
- **A westerly realignment of Golden State Boulevard is required**
- **Avoid impacts to Union Pacific Railroad right of way**
