



City of San Jose High-Speed Train Aerial Alignment Visual Design Guidelines: San Jose Community Working Group (CWG) Meetings Scheduled

High-Speed Train Visual Design Guidelines: The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), working in coordination with the City of San Jose, is preparing visual design guidelines for the proposed High-Speed Train aerial alignment project elements within the city limits of San Jose. Once developed and approved by the Authority board and San Jose City Council, the visual design guidelines will guide the development of high-speed train components, including both functional design and an iconic design, in San Jose.

Community Working Groups: To gather citizen input during the development of the visual design guidelines, the City has formed two Community Working Groups (CWGs), each composed of 10 San Jose citizens that represent a cross-section of the San Jose community. The two CWGs will meet several times over the next four months to provide input on the visual design guidelines.

CWG Meeting Dates: The Monday CWG meetings will focus on the area north of Tamien Station to San Jose city limits, while the Thursday CWG meetings will examine the area south of Tamien Station to Morgan Hill city limits. Each group will cover the same material, but the discussion will focus on these geographical limits.

- Monday CWG meetings (north of Tamien): March 7, April 11, May 23, *June 6
 - The **March 7** meeting will be held from **7-9 pm** at **San Jose City Hall, Rooms W118-119 (200 East Santa Clara Street)**
- Thursday CWG meetings (south of Tamien): March 10, April 14, May 26, *June 9
 - The **March 10** meeting will be held from **6:30-8:30 pm** at **Southside Community Center (5585 Cottle Road)**
