The California High-Speed Rail Authority's public board meeting will be held Wednesday, October 1, at the Fresno Board of Supervisors Chambers located at 2281 Tulare Street, Room 300 in Fresno, California. **Please note the meeting is scheduled to begin at 9:30 am.**

The meeting agenda includes:

- Update on the UC Berkeley study currently underway which focuses on the potential for Transit Oriented Development in the Central Valley led by Professor Elizabeth Deakin.
- Overview of the Fresno Rail Consolidation Study by Bob Schaevitz.
- Presentation of the California High-Speed Rail Economic Impact Report for the Sacramento/Central Valley Area by Shawn Kantor, Ph.D. County Bank Professor of Economics at the University of California, Merced.
- Closed session to confer with legal counsel regarding: *Town of Atherton et al. v California High Speed Rail Authority, Sacramento Superior Court, Case No.34-2008-80000022.*

Highlights of the September 3<sup>rd</sup>, meeting include:

- Report by Stuart Cohen from the Transportation and Land Use Coalition on the feasibility of achieving zero greenhouse gas emissions from the electricity needed to operate the high-speed train system.
- Overview of the master plan for the development of Lindbergh Field by Mike Zdon of San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG).
- Overview of the preliminary design and project-specific environmental rankings for the Altamont, San Francisco to San Jose and the San Jose to Merced corridors. Staff will request authorization to enter into contracts.
