



Final EIR/EIS Now Available

The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) announce the availability of the jointly prepared **Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (Final EIR/EIS) for the Fresno to Bakersfield Section of the California High-Speed Train Project**. Included in the Final EIR/EIS are the Draft General Conformity Determination and Section 4(F) Evaluation.

The Final EIR/EIS and associated documents will be available to the public on April 18, 2014.

The Authority's Board of Directors will hold a two-day board meeting, May 6-7, 2014, to consider whether to certify the Final EIR/EIS under CEQA, which completes the CEQA process, and whether to approve the Fresno to Bakersfield section of the project.

Following the Authority Board of Directors' action on May 7, FRA will consider approving the Fresno to Bakersfield section of the high-speed rail project and issuing a Record of Decision under NEPA. This action is anticipated to occur in June 2014.
